Annual Conference & Annual General Meeting (InterPride 2010)

The InterPride Conference and Annual General Meeting gives LGBTI organizations from throughout the world an opportunity to gather to network and learn best practices with regard to working on LGBTI issues. While the conference and annual meeting gives particular attention to organizing pride festivals which look very different depending on the region of the world, the InterPride Conference also places a big focus on LGBTI human rights issues that may prevent some regions in the world from celebrating LGBTI pride.

Any organization or individual that works on social justice issues for LGBTI individuals and communities can benefit from participating in the Annual InterPride Conference and Annual General Meeting.

The purpose of InterPride Conference & Annual General Meeting is to help its member organizations:

- Conduct programs of an educational purpose for the intent of helping Lesbians Gay Men, Bisexual, Transgender and Intersex persons become more comfortable with who they are;

- Educate the general public towards a better and more accurate understanding of homosexuality, bisexuality, transgender identity and intersex identity
- Facilitate a networking and the sharing of information related to promoting and producing Pride Events and related educational events; and
- Empower and support Pride Organizations in their effort of producing Pride Events.

Call to Presenters

Long Beach Lesbian & Gay Pride (LGBPT) is the host planning committee for InterPride 2010 Conference and Annual General Meeting. As host, the committee is soliciting proposals from would be workshop presenters, facilitators, and speakers. While the host committee has a strong interest in recruiting presenters with demonstrated experience working specifically on LGBTI issues, the committee is also interested in reaching out to those that may not have traditionally worked with on LGBTI issues, but do have transferable knowledge that can meet the needs of the targeted international LGBTI audience.

The planning committee is seeking proposals that include and reflect the perspectives, needs and priorities of an international membership. The Conference will offer sessions that teach and train important skills to advance its cause as described above.

Proposal Review

All proposals will be reviewed by a subcommittee from the InterPride 2010 planning team. Consideration for selection includes relevance of the proposed

session to the goals of InterPride. The proposal document should include proposed workshop content and presenter qualification/experience with the topic as described below.

The committee will not review proposals for sessions that primarily promote or sell commercial products or to promote or sell the work product of an individual presenter. The committee will prioritize proposed sessions that include and reflect the perspectives, needs and priorities of our international movement. The committee reserves the right to decline to review proposals received after the posted deadline.

To have your presentation considered for including in the conference, please complete the attached form and include it with your presentation.

The proposal should be submitted with:

- A 150-200 word abstract which includes the learning objectives of the session, not for publication
- A 50-75 word description and any pre-requisites for attendees, suitable for publication in conference program book
- A session outline that delineates how time will be used in the session and how audience participation “real world” skills practices are to be included, not for publication
- Complete contact information for all presenters, brief biographical information for presenters (maybe used for publication) and resume/or curriculum vita.
